Music Co-Curricular Fee Information 2018

Involvement in the Co-curricular Music program of choirs and bands requires that the student join The Rockhampton Grammar School Music Council (RGSMC). The RGSMC works in direct consultation with the RGS Music Department to provide any assistance that is needed to ensure the continuation of the rich and musically rewarding Co-curricular music experience at the School. We are proud that our financial assistance can benefit music students in their selected Co-curricular activities. Money raised by the RGSMC levy, instrument hire and other fundraising activities has been used to:

- Purchase new instruments and provide repairs and maintenance for existing music equipment – for use in both the Primary and Secondary Departments
- Purchase music scores for choirs and bands
- Purchase of Music Folders for student use
- Financial assistance for two music workshops each year in Term 1 involving tutor costs, flights, accommodation and a sausage sizzle for involved families following the final performance.
- Assist with costs of travel, catering and other expenses involved with participation in activities such as workshops, band competitions and other performances.
- Meet the costs of recording music groups
- Provide catering and theatre costs for Music Department events such as Music Recitals and the Music Festival function
- Funding for additional items to assist the music program, for example, music stand banners, trophy cabinet etc.

Monthly meetings are held at 7.30pm on the 1st Thursday of every month (unless it falls during school holidays). All parents are welcome to attend. Notification of meetings is available in the School Calendar and Daily Notices.
